### **PALs Workshops**

With support from our partners, we had another successful year of expanding our network of PALs and have delivered PALs training to 79 new PALs across 6 counties i.e., Kerry, Longford, Dublin, Louth, Galway and Clare. The groups have shown so much enthusiasm and delight, to be meeting in person once again.

Based on your feedback we have made a change to the PALs workshops so that now a series consists of 6 condensed workshops instead of 8. Our aim is to make the workshops more accessible so that we can increase the number of PALs across Ireland.
